- 2. Head Office: the head office of the Society will be at Jaipur.
- 3. Aims and Objects: Rajasthan Kishan Chhatravas

The aims and objects of the society will be as follows:-

- The found, establish, maintain and run a hostel for the children of Kishans of Rajasthan in particular at Jaipur.
- ii To grant scholarships or aids to poor, needy and deserving Kishan students who receive education in Rajasthan or any where in india.
- iii. To maintain boarding house for Kishans at Jaipur or at other places in india.
- To found, maintain, run or aid any institution for the propagation of the education, culture and technical knowledge of Fine Arts.
- v. To print or publish literature for the propagation of knowledge and to run a Printing press for the said purpose.
- vi. To print and publish News Paper, Journals, Magazines for furthering, protecting and safe goarding the interests of Kishans.
 - To receive and collect donations and funds for the above purpose from any firm, Company, individual or institution.
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- All assets will be in the name of society and no trustees, members or Office bearer of the society can make any claim of any sort on any of the asset of the society and cannot take any direct or indirect benefit from any asset of the society during lifetime or at the time dissolution of the society. In case of Dissolution of society all provisions of the Rajasthan Society Registration Act, 1958 related to dissolution of society will be applicable on this society.

In the case of dissolution of society all provisions of The Rajasthan Society Registration Act, 1958 related to dissolution of society will be applicable one this society.
- 4. Member: There shall be only one class of of the members of the Society i.e.life members.
- 5. Any person who has given a donation of Rs.11,000/- (Eleven thounds) or more in a lum sum to the Society shall be its members for his whole life and shall exercise all the powers and previleges of a member till his life. The amount exceeding 11,000/- (membership) shall be deposited in the Society as donation.


6. Managing Committee

The affairs of the society shall be managed by a managing committee consisting of 13 members (including office bearers) as follows:

- 1. President
- 2. Vice President
- 3. Secretary
- 4. Treasurer
- 5. Joint Secretary
- 6. Eight members.

- 7. The managing committee may frame rules for carrying on its aims and objects and may delegate any or all its powers to the President, Secretary, and member or to any Sub committee appointed from time to time.
- 8. The managing committee shall be elected every five years by the general body of the society.
- Trustees:- all the property moveable and immoveable be longing to the society shall be vested in a Board of Trustees appointed under these rules.
- 10. Every trustee shall be for his life unless:
 - i. He resigns or
 - ii. Becomes physically or mentally incapable for working as a trustee or.
 - iii. Is convicted by a criminal court for an offence involving moral turpitude or
 - iv. Becomes insolvent.
- 11. Rule No. 13. There shall be five trustees of the society:

12. On the death, resignation or retifement of a trutee the other trustee shall fill up the vacancy so created and such new person appointed as trustee shall act as trustee for his life.

13. Financial Commitments:-

The Managing Committee shall manage and carry on the business of the society but proposals involving financial commitments or liabilities shall have no effect unless approved by the trustees.

- 14. Annual Meeting:- There shall be an annual meeting to transact the following business:
 - To read the report of Managing Committee of the society for the year and to discuss the same.
 - To discuss the Balance Sheet and Statement of incomeand Expenditure of the society of the last year.
 - iii. To frame the budget of the society for the next year.
 - iv. To lay down the policy and programme of the society to be carried in the next year.
 - v. To transact any other business as may be placed before it by the managing committee or by any member by the approval of the president.

15. Extraordinary Meeting:-

An extraordinary meeting of the society may be held by the Managing Committee as and when necessary.

16. Accounts:-

All accounts shall be properly kept by the Managing Committee under the guidance of the trustees and shall be duly audited by a duly certified Auditory & DISTI every year before the holding of the General Meeting and the statement of

- 17. The society shall be represented by the Secretary to all people outside and may sue or may be sued in the name of the Secretary.
- 18. The Soceity may frame bye-lays to carry out its aims and objects according to the present rules and regulations and may make amendments and alterations in the said bye-laws.
- 19. No distinctions of caste or creed shall be observed by the society or by its office bearers in the performance of their duties.
